Consequently for 2014, our opinion is:

The main findings are:

- 1. Negative consequences in environmental sector due to institutional no-continuity
- 2. Negative consequences in environmental sector due to (big) personal changes, in particular related EU integration/negotiation tasks
- 3. Implementation of environmental legislation, in many aspects, is "freeze"/"on hold"/postponed
- 4. Financing of environmental sector is not planned, including financing of previously approved strategies (like NEAS)
- 5. Consequences of the abolishment of Environment Fund in 2012, with no substitution mechanism, are still unknown, but expected in medium term to be significant
- 6. Environmental CSOs have to improve their capacities and coordination in order to have stronger role in EU accession processes.
- 7. Noted problems in 2013 Progress Report remain
