



GUIDELINES FOR PAPER PREPARATION

Abstract: *In order to enable presentation of greater amount of material and to simplify printing of the Conference Proceedings, instructions are given for submitting the manuscript for the ninth Regional Conference 2013. Manuscripts must be typewritten according to this instructions.*

Key Words: *Environment / Guidelines / Paper*

1. INTRODUCTION

All papers will be reviewed by International Program Committee. For text originality, quality and accuracy of data and results responsibility lies sole on authors. It is understood that paper has not been previously published and that authors have employer permission to present the results.

The paper should be delivered to Program Committee in electronics form of print-ready document (doc.file). It should be sent until **May 15th, 2011** the latest using **e-mail (as doc. file)** at address: conference.ene13@gmail.com

The length of paper is **3-6 pages** including figures, tables, references and appendices.

2. FORMATING THE PAGE

The paper should be written using Microsoft Word 97 text editor (or later versions). It is recommended to use Times New Roman font 10 pt. Paper Size: A4 (210x297 mm); Orientation: Portrait. Margins to be used are: **3 cm** top, **2.5 cm** bottom, left and right.

2.1. Paper organization and type size

The paper should begin with title, in two lines at most, using capital letters only (bold, 24pt). Please allow 5 spaces (10 pt) above the title for the symposium logo, which would be inserted by organizer. Below the title, after a space, write the authors names (normal, 12 pt) and affiliation (11 pt), as it is shown in this instruction.

Abstract of the paper (italic, 10 pt) of no more than 200 words and 3 to 7 Key Words (bolditalic, 10 pt) should follow after 2 spaces.

Headings should be written with capital letters, bold, of 10 pt size. The first heading (1. INTRODUCTION) write with 2 spaces above. Subheadings should be written with small letters, bold, size 10 pt. The rest of the

paper should be written with 10 pt letter size, as it is shown in this instruction.

The final paper appearance should be as this instruction is look like.

3. EQUATIONS

Equations are written with numbering by the rights side, as

$$J \frac{d\varphi(t)}{dt} + K\varphi(t) = m_e(t) - m_m(t). \quad (1)$$

The variables in equations and in the text body should be written in italic.

4. TABLES AND FIGURES

Tables, figures, diagrams, block schemes and other drawings should be inserted into text. Above the table, the table number and name should be written, and below – explanation of signs and abbreviations, if they have been used in the table.

Table 1. *Experimental results*

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Figures, diagrams, block schemes must be made using special software or scanned and inserted into text (file). Use black and white technique. The photographs which are going to be scanned, should be sharp with high contrast. Figure captions are written below the figure, centered, in italic.

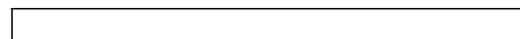


Fig. 5. *Illustration of the ...*
