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EU Seventh Environmental Action Program: EIA and SEA are effective tools when correctly implemented

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Abstract

This paper is highlighted “the new wave of” the support to Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and Strategic Impact Assessment (SEA) as the effective tools, through recently approved EU Seventh Environmental Action Program (Decision No 1386/2013/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 November 2013 on a General Union Environment Action Programme to 2020 ‘Living well, within the limits of our planet). The 7th Environment Action Programme (7EAP) is guiding European environment policy until 2020. In order to give more long-term direction it sets out a vision beyond that, of where it wants the Union to be by 2050, by nine key objectives. All measures, actions and targets set out in the 7th EAP should be taken forward in accordance with the principles of smart regulation and, where appropriate, subject to a comprehensive impact assessment. EIA and SEA are the substance of the priority objective seven, but also mentioned in the priority objective five:

- In order to improve environmental integration and policy coherence, the 7th EAP shall ensure that by 2020 fully implementing the Strategic Environmental Assessment Directive and the Environmental Impact Assessment Directive;
- Member States should make information gathered to assess environmental impacts of plans, programmes and projects (e.g. through Environmental or Strategic Impact Assessments) more accessible to the public.

Through analysis the terms and practices related to correct implementation, fully implementation and more accessible to the public, this paper intends to contribute to the better understanding of these issues by different angles, professionals and sectors, in particular in candidate and potential candidate to EU membership countries.
